

TOWN OF RUSK
ORDINANCE NO. 2019—01
ADDING **COORDINATES**
REDEFINING CERTAIN GPS POINTS FOR NO WAKE AREAS
ON CLEAR, CHAIN AND McCANN LAKES

WHEREAS, the Board of the Town of Rusk wishes to add additional data in the form of GPS coordinates to the existing buoy marker ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, to that end, the Board of the Town of Rusk wishes to amend the Town of Rusk and Big Bend Joint Boating Ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of the Town of Rusk does ordain that the Town Ordinance code is amended as follows: (Added language is *italicized* and underlined).

Sec. 12-1-1* Towns of Rusk and Big Bend Joint Boating Ordinance – (d) No Wake Areas

**see Big Bend municipal code*

(d) No Wake Areas.

(1) No person shall operate a boat in the following area at a speed faster than “Slow-No Wake”, as defined in Sec. 30.50(12), Wis. Stats., as “that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control”. Said “No Wake” areas are:

- a. In the Town of Rusk in the channel between Clear Lake and Chain Lake located in the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4, T33N, R9W, Section 36.
- b. In the Town of Big Bend in the channel between McCann Lake and Chain Lake in the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4, T33N, R8W, Section 31.

(2) This area will be indicated by buoys placed at each end of the restricted area, as follows.

(1) Markers for No Wake – GPS Coordinates and Labeling

a. McCann Lake

i. No Wake

1. Lat N45° 18' 14.10" / Long W91° 24' 56.17"

ii. No Wake

1. Lat N45° 18' 22.20" / Long W91° 24' 10.35"

b. Clear Lake

i. No Wake

1. Lat N45° 18' 00.69" / Long W91° 25' 17.82"

ii. No Wake

1. Lat N45° 17' 58.58" / Long W91° 25' 15.57"
