

Request for Bids — TOWN OF RUSK

The Town of Rusk in Rusk County is requesting separate, sealed bids for the following road work projects to be completed in the township this summer:

1. Replace three culverts on Horseshoe Lake Road

- a. The culverts lie in the segment just west of CTH W
- b. Cover with 6" road grade material
- c. Township will supply plastic culverts

2. Grinding of blacktop in three locations

- a. On Horseshoe Lake Road: the approximately 1.15 mile east from CTH W
- b. On N. Potato Lake Road: the approximately .5 mile south of Deer Head Point Rd., to the end
- c. On Old Hwy. D, the approximately .25 mile from CTH D to the end
- d. Please bid each job separately, as well as all together

3. 9,500 yards, more or less, of State-approved $\frac{3}{4}$ " crushed road gravel, furnished, loaded, hauled, and truck-spread to multiple locations

- a. Approx. 5,000 yards to Horseshoe Lake Road: the 1.15 mile east of CTH W
- b. Approx. 2,500 yards to N. Potato Lake Road: the .5 mile south of Deer Head Pt. Rd., to the end
- c. Approx. 2,000 yards to other location(s) in the township
- d. Town will level and grade
- e. Please price bid in yards (not tons)

For All Bids:

- Bidder shall supply signage
- Completion date to be agreed upon at assigning of contract
- Please include your certificate(s) of insurance *
