

Request for Bids / Proposals

TOWN OF RUSK, Rusk County, Wisc.

Bids/proposals for the following road work will be accepted until 7 p.m. on Thursday, April 12, 2018, at the Town of Rusk Town Hall, N704 Cty. F, Chetek; or prior to that, via mail: Town of Rusk Clerk, P.O. Box 61, Chetek, WI, 54728. Each submitted envelope should be labeled with one of these titles: BLACKTOPPING / SHOULDERING / GRAVEL / GRINDING.

BLACKTOPPING BID

Now accepting sealed bids for two blacktopping jobs. Submit bids as price per ton.

- approximately 5540 feet (~1.1 mile) of Horseshoe Lake Road just east of CTH W—measure includes an approach onto Pleasant Ridge Road. Work to be provided will consist of 2½-inch compacted depth x 22-foot width E-1 hot mix or warm mix asphalt, including all watering, fine grading, flagging, etc.
- approximately 7920 feet (~1.5 mile) of County Line Road, north from intersection with CTH D. Work to be provided will consist of 1-inch depth x 22-foot width asphalt overlay.

SHOULDERING PROPOSAL

Now accepting sealed proposals for the shouldering of the approximately 5540 feet (~1.1 mile) of Horseshoe Lake Road east from intersection with CTH W—including an approach onto Pleasant Ridge Road. Work to be provided will consist of installing 3-foot shoulders using ¾-inch gravel and compacting, grading, and clearing loose gravel, with customary signage, flagging, etc. Submit proposal as price per yard. This work will be coordinated with blacktopping.

GRAVEL BID

Now accepting sealed bids for approximately 6,000 yards, more or less, of State-approved crushed road gravel, furnished, loaded, hauled, and truck-spread to two or more locations. Weight slips required.

- Approximately 4,000 yards to the .8-mile of Horseshoe Lake Road, west from CTH W
- Approximately 2,000 yards to several locations throughout the township

NOTE: *The Class B Highway restriction on Horseshoe Lake Road will be waived for the above road projects.*

GRINDING PROPOSAL

Now accepting sealed proposals for grinding of the approximately 4,224-feet (~.8 mile) of blacktop on Horseshoe Lake Road, west from CTH W. Existing blacktop is 2-inches in depth and 22-feet wide.

The successful providers will be required to submit a certificate of insurance showing liability and worker's comp insurances before work can commence. Please include certificate(s) of insurance with your submission(s).
